- ❖ At PS 110’s After-School Program, students were able to use sidewalk chalk to draw pictures in the playground at PS 110. The third grade group is having fun with their weekly Adventure Time. This week the students answered trivia questions based off of pop culture. The new Pre-K class is learning how to effectively share with one another during both instruction and free play time.
- ❖ In our After-School at 301 Program, students are learning how to make a movie/slide show to tie into their All About Community projects.
