- Patience and willingness to work in a diverse environment
- Fluent in Spanish, Cantonese, and Mandarin preferred, though not required

Responsibilities:

- Participate volunteer orientation before event date
- Provide sufficient supplies to facilitate activity for the expected number of participants
- Ensure that all materials have been prepared before the event
- Communicate any needs or challenges to staff on hand
- Foster a welcoming and safe environment.
