She served as Parent Center Social Worker/Program Coordinator from 2014-2017 and has since developed a wide range of family-centered trainings to support healthy child and family development. She completed her MA Degree in Mental Health Counseling at the Nyack College Alliance Graduate School of Counseling (AGSC). Prior to joining the Parent Center Team in 2020, she conducted intakes and facilitated supportive counseling groups at Henry Street Settlement's Community Consultation Center in the PROS Program.
