Henry Street's Job Plus office, 24 Avenue D (at East Third Street), served as a pop-up enrollment site for the IDNYC. At this location, Lower East Side residents had access the new program which issues New York City identification cards to anyone 14 years or older, regardless of immigration status.

The enrollment site opened with a press conference hosted by New York City Council Member Rosie Mendez, who said that the location of the new site is especially important to reach residents of the nearby public housing projects.
