PARTICIPANTS WILL OBTAIN INSTRUCTION IN:

- + Construction Math and Measurement
- + Tool Usage
- + 70 hours of roofing instruction in a lab environment
- + OSHA 30 certification
- + 16 hour scaffolding certification

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- + 18 and over
- + Completed 10th grade (transcript required)
- + Pass a math and reading exam
- + A NYCHA resident (on the lease) in Red Hook, Gowanus, Sheepshead Bay, Coney Island, The Rockaways, The Lower East Side, or Canarsie
- + Pass a drug test at the start of training as required by Roofers Union Local 8
- + Comfortable with extreme heights

- + Stipend will be provided to program graduates
