Our team is trained to support adults ages 18+ in transitional and supportive housing, in recovery from substance abuse, or with past legal system involvement. Beyond therapy, CONNECT offers free support groups including peer recovery, life skills, healthy relationships, and art making. CONNECT Community Liaison Lainey Perez says, "These groups were created based on community feedback. Your voice truly matters here." CONNECT also has a food pantry, open by appointment.
